Tasting Notes

This approachable Bordeaux-style blend offers aromas of raspberry and plum sitting atop undertones of warm wood spice and mocha. On the palate, this dry, medium-bodied wine is well-balanced, with flavors of black cherry and cassis and delicate notes of black tea and allspice.

Thoughts for Food

Enjoy this wine with hearty meals, such as braised venison, lamb, or beef, as well as rich pasta and stews. Suggested dishes include beef wellington, pot roast, and rack of lamb.
